## Current and Prospective International Students

**The Department of International Relations would like to transmit the following information on behalf of the Ministry of Home Affairs and Immigration to current and prospective NUST international students.**

1. As from 2016 study permits will be linked to the duration of study period.
2. The study permits fees remain N\$1 395 per year excluding the handling fee of N\$80.00.
3. The study permit fee amount will be multiplied with a number of years a particular student will take to complete his or her studies.
4. Officials from the Ministry of Home Affairs and Immigration will be present at NUST Campus, House No. 1 Johann Albrecht Street, as from 01 to 19 February 2016 to renew study permits and receive new study permit applications.
5. Study permits applications can also be submitted at the Ministry of Home Affairs and Immigration from 01 December 2015 until 31 March 2016.
6. International students should take note that the Ministry of Home Affairs and Immigration will not allow a change of condition by any international student who could not submit academic records for the previous academic year; neither will it entertain any employment permit from the students whose skills can be obtained from the job market in Namibia.
