#### Responsibilities

Coordinate the identification, recruitment, tutoring, and performance monitoring activities of the AGYW; plan, organise and provide tutorial lessons to the AGYW of both primary and secondary school age; compile and submit weekly reports; participate and represent NUST at school activities such as the School-Parents Board meetings and any other meetings deemed essential for the DREAMS project; collaborate with other stakeholders of the DREAMS project and perform any other duties related to the capacity development of the AGYW.
